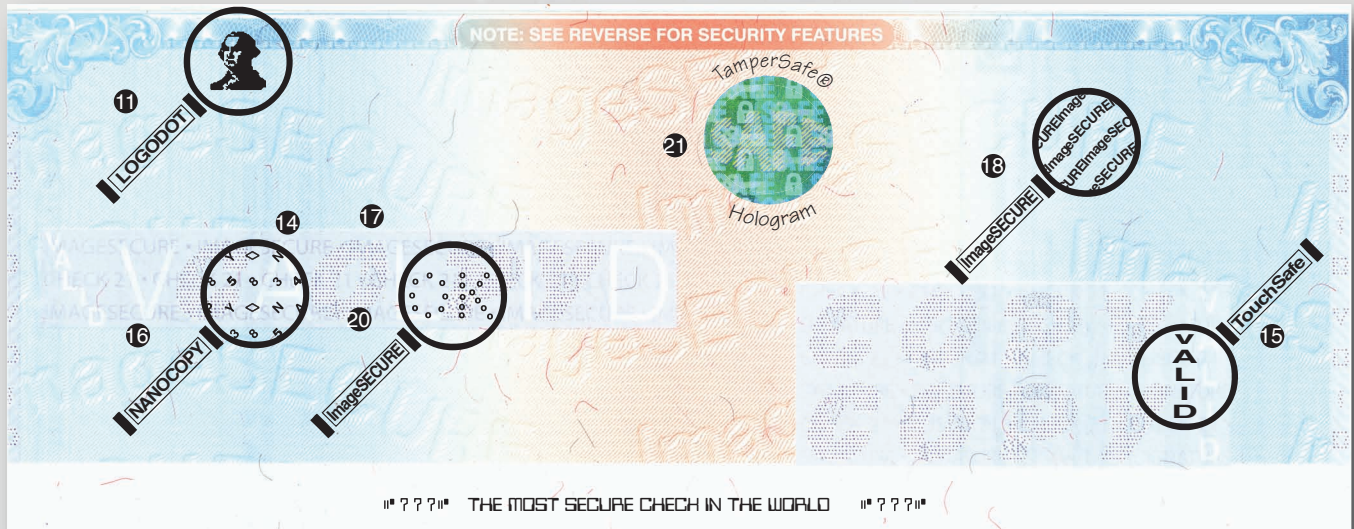

ImageSECURE™ has 21 security features.

1. Controlled security paper stock (not available to the open market)
2. SafedImage™ true fourdrinier watermark (unique "Verify First" multi-tone images)
3. Embedded fluorescent fibers (become visible under ultraviolet light)
4. Chemical wash protection (protects against chemical alterations)
5. Toner retention (enhances toner adhesion for alteration protection)
6. Engraved border with thermochromic edges (intricate design is difficult to copy)
7. Warning band (calls attention to security)
8. Full bleed borders
9. Prismatic pastel printing (very difficult to copy and will drop out for Check 21 compliance)
10. Micro text printing (on both the front and back)
11. LogoDot® (minute images of the American flag and George Washington in the border)
12. Visible fibers (minute blue and red fibers embedded into the paper)
13. Variable laid lines (variable line widths on back to deter cut and paste alterations)
14. ThermoHide™ (invisible word "VALID" appears in amount area when warmed)
15. TouchSafe® (invisible word "VALID" appears in signature field when warmed)
16. NaNOcopy™ (the warning word "COPY" appears when copied or scanned)
17. Fluorescent VALID (invisible word "VALID" appears under ultraviolet "black" light)
18. ImageSECURE™ pantograph (a complex micro text pattern is printed producing relief images)
19. ImageSECURE™ digital (the highly secure micro text background has an encrypted secret message)
20. ImageSECURE™ minute images which survive scanning for Check 21 compliance.
21. Optional hologram (a three dimensional "TamperSafe" security hologram)
